Erdinger is THE name of Weisse beer producers, the top producer of a style of beer that is unique to Germany. The difference? These beers are brewed from wheat and combine a zingy freshness with a warm, spicy character. They are quite unlike anything else and in Bavaria, home of Erdinger, they are suitably proud of their remarkable weissebier.

Can a beer be really complex, like a fine wine? Well, Erdinger certainly is. The slightly cloudy Weissbier and Dunkel smell, to me, of cloves, incense and very ripe banana. Honestly! The Kristal is bright and clear, looks like a lager but has a seductive spiciness. Even the alcohol-free version is packed with favour. Spicy, full-throttle flavour, round and generous – that's the Erdinger house style.
