

THE NUMBER ONE SELLING BEER IN GERMANY

Krombacher

4.8% ABV

Krombacher, from North Rhine/Westfalia, is a pure classic of the genre and it seems that the mountain water of the Rothaargebirge spring has a lot to do with the character of the beer.

The first thing you will notice about Krombacher is the assertive fragrance. Krombacher smells of malt and even more of the perfume of hops. It's a seductive scent that invites you to start tasting without delay. It's big and broad in terms of flavour and this is underpinned by an alcohol content of 4.8% abv but lingering flavour – what you get on the very finish – it is combination of potent maltiness and the slightly bitter, very clean taste of hops. Krombacher is crisp and refreshing but there's a lot more to it than that: it's a great thirst – quencher but it's also a big beer in every sense.
