Budejovicky Budvar. 'Treasured By Generations'.

The noblest female cones of fine saaz hops, pure virgin spring water, and carefully selected grain of special Moravian barley make it the drink for real connoisseurs. The 700-year tradition of producing Budejovicky Budvar beer and the exclusive 90-day maturing period enhance its uniqueness. (5% ABV)

Budejovicky Budvar Non Alcoholic:

The combination of traditional Budvar brewing methods and the use of only the highest quality natural ingredients creates a beer with a delicate, full flavour but a minimum content of alcohol for those who enjoy a great beer flavour but don't want an alcoholic beverage. (ABV 0.5%)

Erdinger Hefe Weissbier. 'The world's most popular wheat beer'.

Erdinger weissbier 'with fine yeast' is quite simply the wheat beer par excellence. It is brewed using fine yeast according to a traditional recipe and, of course, in strict accordance with the Bavarian purity law of 1516: only water, yeast, hops and malt are used. Traditional bottle fermentation – similar to the champagne method – gives Erdinger its uniquely refreshing taste. (5.3% ABV)

Erdinger Kristall weiße. 'The famous Bavarian speciality'.

This speciality wheat beer gets its 'crystal clear' appearance from a particularly long filtration process, known in the industry as 'fine filtration', whereby the beer becomes completely clear. This gives Erdinger Kristall its sparkling and refreshing character – which also makes it the ideal wheat beer for warm summer days. (5.3% ABV)

Erdinger Dunkel weiße:

Dunkel is the dark member of the family, the darkness comes from the selected darkly roasted malt used in the brewing process. This wonderful dark brew has extra strength and depth, retaining the sediment of the Hefe Weiss which creates a complex cloudy wheat beer. (5.3% ABV).

Erdinger Non-Alcoholic weiße. 'The sports and fitness drink'.

Erdinger's master brewers have succeeded in retaining the aromatic, full-bodied Erdinger character - even without the alcohol. Containing all B vitamins and just 25kcal per 100ml. At last a non-alcoholic beer that tastes great! (0,4% ABV)

Erdinger Oktoberfest weiße:

This seasonal beer is brewed exclusively for Oktoberfest celebrations around the world. This celebratory beer is brewed using fine yeast according to a traditional recipe and, like all Erdinger beers, in strict accordance with the Bavarian purity law of 1516: only water, yeast, hops and malt are used. Erdinger Oktoberfest beer has a freshness which allows it to be enjoyed at Oktoberfest events from Cincinnati to Hong Kong. (5.7% ABV).

Food pairing: *"The highly palatable ERDINGER Oktoberfest is not only a perfect complement to all hearty Oktoberfest dishes, such as roast chicken or cold cuts of meat and bread, but also tastes great with juicy steaks or strong cheeses"*

Erdinger Schneeweiße (snow-white):

A seasonal beer brewed from November to February, "snow-white" uses the first malts from the summer harvest. It's not until mid October that the wheat beer specialty develops its amber color and spicy flavor - a result of its long maturing period. "Snow-white" goes particularly well with hearty food - something not uncommon during the Christmas season! (5.6% ABV)

Erdinger Pikantus Dark Bock:

At 7.3% alcohol, this specialty wheat beer has a considerably higher alcohol content than other varieties produced by Erdinger Weissbräu. The dark bock beer owes its sharp and full flavor to the use of selected dark wheat and barley malts and a significantly longer maturing process.

In contrast to many bock beers, Erdinger Pikantus 'dark bock beer' does not taste too sweet. Despite its higher alcohol content, Erdinger's master brewers have succeeded in retaining the smooth Pikantus flavour (7.3% ABV).

Erdinger UrweiÙe:

A particularly strong, spicy aroma, a distinctive yeast flavor and an unmistakable top-fermenting beer profile - these are the characteristics of ERDINGER's new family member in good old Bavarian tradition. The recipe for Urweisse dates back to the brewery's founding days over 120 years ago. It owes its distinctive, traditional weissbier flavor to a special malt, a different hop variety and a special yeast. (4.9% ABV).

Fischers Helles Beer:

'Helles' is German for 'bright'. Brewed in strict accordance with the Reinheitsgebot of 1516. München brewmasters created Helles Lager in response to the golden and clean lagers of nearby south Bohemia . A bit more malty, Fischers shares some of the same spicy hop characters of Czech Pilsners, but has a more rounded flavour and finish. A real Bavarian Speciality (5.5% ABV)

Forst Birra Italiana:

The brewery "FORST" was founded in the year 1857 and has its home in the town of Forst high in the South Tyrolean area of Italy. As the foundation of any great beer is the water used in the brewing process, Forst is in the enviable position of having its own mineral water source with which to create a beer of great quality. The brewery uses many modern technologies to brew their beer which is very famous for its stand-out dry flavour which makes it the perfect beer style for any Italian food. Forst Birra Italiana is available in a 6x330ml pack and can be found at all good beer stores (4.8% ABV).

Krombacher Pils. 'Germany's #1 Premium Beer'.

Soft mountainous spring water, select raw materials and a well guarded brewing recipe make Krombacher Pils a unique experience in taste. With an extra dry finish, this is a classic example of Pilsner at its' best. Brewed according to the German beer purity regulations. (4.8% ABV)

Krombacher Dark:

Rich, dark and complex, Krombacher Dark has an intriguing depth of flavour. A variety of roasted malts are combined with natural spring water. This full bodied beer is lightly hopped and rich in malt for a well-balanced character. (4.3% ABV)

Krombacher Non Alcoholic:

The purest ingredients and the care taken in the brewing process creates a beer of great style and flavour without the alcohol. Krombacher NA enjoys a distinctive, crisp and refreshing taste with a mild hop aroma. (0.5% ABV)

Cloughmore Heather IPA – Whitewater Brewery, Ireland.

Cloughmore Heather IPA is brewed in the foothills of the Mourne mountains and draws its main ingredient from the local water supplied from Silent Valley reservoir. The initial wort is created with 4 malt varieties. While in the copper, the first hops are added to create bitterness and aroma and a muslin pellet filled with Mourne heather is inserted to infuse the beer with floral tones. This is then matured for 3 weeks before a final dry-hopping is added for additional bite. This is a single-hopped IPA brewed in the traditional style resulting in a darker character than our American cousins. Unpasteurised and finely filtered and free from any artificial additives or preservatives, the beer may contain a small amount of sediment. This is Craft Irish IPA at its finest. (5.2% ABV)

Cloughmore Dark Water Stout – Whitewater Brewery, Ireland.

Cloughmore Dark Water Stout is brewed in the foothills of the Mourne mountains and draws its main ingredient from the local water supplied from Silent Valley reservoir. Roasted barley and rolled oats create the depth of body of the stout and this is then augmented with a rich hop flavour. Unfiltered and free from any artificial additives or preservatives, this is Craft Irish Stout at its finest. (4.2% ABV)

Cloughmore Granite Lager – Whitewater Brewery, Ireland.

Cloughmore Granite Lager is brewed in the foothills of the Mourne mountains and draws its main ingredient from the local water supplied from Silent Valley reservoir. This is a full-flavoured lager brewed with a combination of hops sourced in England, Czech Republic and USA. The brew is then lagered for a minimum of 3 weeks resulting in a bright, full-bodied beer. Finely filtered and free from any artificial additives or preservatives, the beer may contain a small amount of sediment. This is Craft Irish Lager at its finest. (4.5% ABV)

Buried At Sea – Galway Bay Brewery, Ireland.

Tasting note: Tasting - This Dark and full bodied stout lends its smooth taste to the use of milk sugars and chocolate used in the brewing process. The decadent flavour is well balanced to give a very drinkable and refreshing pint. The roasty nature of the dark malts allows this beer to find its place well beside any grilled or barbecue foods and its full-body and sweetness sits with any rich, chocolate dessert.(4.5% ABV)

Althea Session Ale – Galway Bay Brewery, Ireland.

Althea is a modern American Pale Ale. Unlike many pales, Althea is low on bitterness, yet massively hoppy on the aroma. Named after one of our head brewer's favourite Grateful Dead songs; Althea is a beer that can be enjoyed by the pint or by the glass! (4.8% ABV)

Full Sail IPA – Galway Bay Brewery, Ireland.

Tasting - This hoppy American style ale uses solely US hops and in great quantities both in the kettle and in two stages of dry-hopping. This combines to give a strong hop presence and aroma with a refreshing, palate cleansing bitterness. Food pairings include spicy dishes, Mexican dishes and creamy cheeses. (5.8% ABV)

Bay Ale – Galway Bay Brewery, Ireland.

Tasting - Our Red Ale is malt-forward, copper coloured ale with a hop profile chosen to accentuate these characteristics yet ultimately strike a balance in flavour. Food pairings include Salads, Cold Meat Sandwiches and Battered Fish (4.4% ABV)

Of Foam & Fury DIPA - Galway Bay Brewery, Ireland.

Of Foam & Fury is a US-Style DIPA using Galena, Pacific Jade, Chinook and Simcoe hops. On the nose refreshing, pine-wood forests with a subtle touch of exotic spice in the background which carries forward onto the flavour. Massive malt backbone gives this beer a mighty 8.5% ABV which, in turn, lends a certain sweetness to balance the massive 132 IBU's. This is hopped with a blend of Chinook, Galena, Pacific Jade and Simcoe, and two rounds of dry-hopping to boot.

And Union – Unfiltered Helles Lager – Bavaria, Germany.

An Old school lager, brewed with Hallertau aroma hops, unfiltered and unpasteurized for a fuller flavour. Perfect with Appetizers, spicy foods, calamari, oysters, prawns, pork chops, salami (5% ABV)

And Union – Dark Lager – Bavaria, Germany.

A rich and complex lager. Coffee coloured and brewed with Hallertau aroma hops and toasted malt, Dark Lager is a perfect companion for oxtail, game, stews, beef sausages, burgers and steaks (5% ABV)

And Union – Handwerk, Unfiltered India Pale Ale – Bavaria, Germany.

A zippy, fresh, fruity and gentle introduction to the India Pale Ale beer style. Brewed with Hallertau Aroma and American hops, this is a hazy, copper coloured beer which goes down easy with cream based pastas, fried foods, mature cheese and curries. (5.5% ABV)

And Union – Friday, Unfiltered India Pale Ale – Bavaria, Germany.

This is the And Union tribute to the new wave of American IPAs. Brewed with Hallertau Aroma and American hops, this is a hazy, copper coloured beer which goes down easy with North Indian curries, BBQ, Cajun and Schezuan dishes. Not for woosies! (6.5% ABV)

And Union – Sunday, Unfiltered India Pale Ale – Bavaria, Germany.

A balanced and gently spiced, easy-drinking Sunday Pale Ale. Brewed with Hallertau Aroma and American hops, this is a golden, hazy sunset style beer which goes well with seafood, shellfish, fried foods and spicy pork. (5.5% ABV)

And Union – Beast of the Deep, Unfiltered Heller Bock – Bavaria, Germany.

A naughty, creamy and decadent lager. Brewed with Hallertau Aroma and American hops, this deep golden beer goes well with gammon, eisbein, pork crackling and German-style pork and pulled pork dishes. (6.5% ABV)

Samuel Adams Boston Lager:

Since 1985, The Boston Beer Company has become widely respected for the quality of their beers, and for the creativity and innovation deployed in developing, brewing, and selling these beers. The brewers use traditional brewing methods and follow sound brewing fundamentals to ensure that the Boston beers are always of the highest quality. Innovative recipes and ingredients are used in creating exciting new styles of beer (38 beers currently in production) and while these ingredients and recipes combine to create fine beers, there always remains a bit of mystery and wonder as the brewing process transforms into a world-renowned product.

The Boston Beer Company, like the beers, is the result of a combination of tradition, human chemistry, creativity, and wonder. Company traditions are those of quality, growth, respect for others, open-mindedness, and hard work and the belief that everyone has a valuable contribution to make.

Samuel Adams Boston Lager is the undisputed trail blazer of American craft beer a staple of the "craft beer" world. The beer has a rich and dark tone and is full-flavored with a balance of malty sweetness contrasted by hop spiciness and a smooth finish (4.8% ABV).

Samuel Adams Noble Pils:

Sam Adams Noble Pils is imported directly from Boston. It is brewed with all 5 Noble Pils for a distinct hop character and fresh taste. Deep golden in colour with a citrusy hop aroma, Noble Pils is a traditional Bohemian Pilsner. The honeyed malt character from traditional Bohemian malt is balanced by delicate yet pronounced citrus, floral and piney notes from the Noble hops. (4.8% ABV)

Samuel Adams Summer Ale:

Samuel Adams® Summer Ale is an American wheat ale. This summer seasonal uses malted wheat, lemon peel and Grains of Paradise, a rare pepper from Africa first used as a brewing spice in the 13th century, to create a crisp taste, spicy flavor and medium body. The ale fermentation imparts a background tropical fruit note reminiscent of mangos and peaches. All of these flavors come together to create a thirst quenching, clean finishing beer perfect for those warm summer days. (5.3% ABV)

Samuel Adams Harvest Pumpkin:

The first pumpkin ales were born when early New England colonists added pumpkin to their beers in place of traditional malts. Today, Sam Adams Harvest Pumpkin Ale is brewed with over 17 pounds of real pumpkin per barrel. This dark, reddish-amber brew has a full body and sweetness complemented by a distinct roasted character and subtle spice note from the pumpkin pie spices. (5.7%)

Samuel Adams Winter Lager:

Full-bodied and robust from the generous quantities of malted wheat. The holiday spice blend melds with the smooth lager fermentation character to give the beer a long and complex finish. (5.6%)

Little Creatures Pale Ale: 'Australia's Finest'

Bag loads of Cascade and Galaxy whole hop flowers that are sourced direct from hop growers in Victoria, Tassie and the US are thrown at Little Creatures Pale Ale, creating an intense citrus and grapefruit aroma and flavour that is balanced with a careful selection of specialty malts and a local Western Australian pale malt made to the specification of the Brewmaster.

Preservative and additive-free, Little Creatures Pale Ale is live-yeast conditioned in bottles and kegs for unmatched

freshness and character.

From brewing to release, a batch of pale ale takes about six weeks, allowing for two weeks conditioning in the bottle after packaging.

No artificial additives are included, just great ingredients. Pour it into a glass to enjoy it at its best! (5.2%ABV)

Bishops Finger. *'Kentish Strong Ale'*

The dominant character of this premium ale is its generous, fruity flavour, reminiscent of bananas and pears with citrus overtones. A full bodied, nut-brown, nourishing ale with a lingering hoppy finish, an ideal companion to food or it can serve as a delicious digestive after a meal. (5.4% ABV)

Spitfire Kentish Ale:

Crafted from traditional varieties of English malt, this golden ale combines an underlying depth of maltiness, tinged with a subtle hint of toffee, with the bold citrus and fruity spiciness of Kentish hops, to produce a well balanced, thirst quenching, popular drink. (4.5% ABV)

Whitstable Bay Organic Ale:

This elegant, light beer is backed by the impressive essentials of traditionally farmed, English malted barley and organic hops from New Zealand, which fuse to produce a bittersweet flavour with floral overtones and a dry finish. (4.5% ABV)

1698 Celebration Ale:

A light coloured but warming strong ale, sweet, rounded, full and mellow, enhanced by fruity and flowery flavours of traditional leaf hops. An ale to sip and savour in comfort and at leisure. (6.5% ABV)

Shepherd Neame Classic Series India Pale Ale:

A classic IPA with a decent original gravity. This will give the beer really good body and mouthfeel. Bitterness needs to be high so Pale Ale malt will be used with a generous amount of crystal malt to give flavour and a good, rich golden colour. Hopped at three stages with two varieties of locally grown Kentish hops, Target for bitterness and classic East Kent Goldings for aroma and flavour. (6.1% ABV)

Shepherd Neame Classic Series Double Stout:

Tasting Note: The idea is to create something really old and traditional. Full of dark coloured and roasted malts with the flavours they contribute to the beer, the opportunity to brew a great stout with pale, crystal, brown and chocolate malts plus roasted barley and flaked oats is just too good to pass up. Bitterness has to be high for this 5.2%abv beer , so Target hops are used to give the bitterness that will compliment the fantastically complex, malty notes of the beer . Not looking for much hop aroma, malts and bitterness must dominate this stout. (5.2%)

Samuel Smiths Pure Brewed Organic Lager:

An outstanding lager brewed for optimum purity with organically grown malted barley and hops; matured at low temperatures to bring out its delicate fruity flavour from the yeast, balanced with malt and a pleasant hop-character finish. (5% ABV)

Samuel Smiths Pure Brewed Organic Pale Ale:

A full-strength ale with a good balance of malt and hops to give a full, rounded flavour and aftertaste that drinks well with food (5% ABV)

Samuel Smiths Pure Brewed Organic Chocolate Stout:

A delicious full-bodied sweet stout with roasted barley flavour; fruity notes from the Samuel Smith yeast support lush, chocolate aroma, taste & finish. (5% ABV)

Samuel Smiths Pure Brewed Organic Strawberry Beer

Soft and subtle, the smooth malt and, aromatic strawberry flavours merge together in an elegant style with fresh ripe strawberries shining through. (5.1%)

Samuel Smiths Pure Brewed Organic Cherry Beer

High natural acidity makes sour cherries a great choice for creating the ultimate fruit beer; the vibrant cherry character is perfectly underpinned by deliciously complex beer notes (5.1%)

Samuel Smiths Pure Brewed Organic Apricot Beer

Ripe, aromatic bouquet supporting a sweet summery flavour with just a suggestion of stone-fruit tartness; rich and full-bodied, the colour is glowing orange; sometimes this fruit beer has a natural haze (5.1%)

Samuel Smiths Pure Brewed Organic Raspberry Beer

A dramatic fruit beer with an intense, mouth-watering fruit character derived from the natural acidity of organic raspberries; smooth body, finishes dry, with a soft raspberry note. (5.1%)

Samuel Smiths Pure Brewed Organic Cider

Made with the juice from organic apples, a medium dry cider with brilliant straw colour, light body, clean apple flavour and a gentle apple blossom finish.

Samuel Smiths Pure Brewed Organic Perry

Made with the juice from organic pears, a medium dry perry with brilliant straw colour, light body, clean pear flavour and a gentle finish.

Asahi Super Dry.

As the name suggests, Asahi is a full tasting beer with a 'super dry' finish. The biggest selling beer in Japan offers full taste and flavour and is a perfect easy-drinking beer. (5% ABV)

Japans oldest beer brand is rich in flavor yet easy on the palate, the perfect accompaniment for any Asian-inspired foods (4.8% ABV)

Er Boqueron:

Er Boqueron is brewed by La Socarrada near Valencia who are one of the upcoming breed of Spanish craft brewers. Uniquely, Er Boqueron is brewed using Mediterranean sea water sourced from a supplier who specializes in the treatment of sea water for food use (see <http://www.aguademar.es/en> for more info). This is a collaboration between La Socarrada, Mediterranea, The Foundation for Nutritional Research and the Foundation for the Mediterranean Diet. For the brewing process, micro-filtered seawater is mixed in with the mash at the early stages of brewing. Seawater makes up less than 20% of the total water used in the brewing process so there is no residual saline tones. The beer is unpasteurized, unfiltered and without added gas which results in a deep copper coloured beer with fine bubbles and full malty aroma with a mix of notes from fruit to dry grass (4.8% ABV)

CIDERS:

Aspall Suffolk Organic Cyder.

Rich, golden colour; traditional bittersweet cyder-apple aroma with orchard fruit and floral notes. Palate initially slightly sweet, then mouthfilling and full bodied. Complex array of fruit flavours balanced by gorgeous soft tannins, producing a bone dry finish. Very long aftertaste, a true sign of a classic cyder of the highest quality” An ideal partner for highly flavoured meat dishes, especially duck confit and exotic food from Asia and North African with a hint of sweetness. (7% ABV)

Aspall Suffolk Premier Cru.

Mid straw-gold colour with a clean, light aroma of dessert apples. Dry, round and creamy on the palate with a good acid balance, pleasant soft tannins and elegant, long finish. A highly versatile partner for all kinds of food, for example charcuterie, sweet & spicy, and a variety of cheeses. (7% ABV)

Aspall Suffolk Draught Cyder.

Made by the same family for 8 generations and using only the pressed juice of the finest English apple, Aspall cyder has a mid-straw colour with a floral/apple aroma, especially russets. Lovely mouth filling mousse and delicate flavour of fresh pressed apples Off-dry and quite complex, enhancing the long finish. Ideal as an aperitif and as partner to a variety of fish based dishes as well as spicy & well flavoured savoury food. (5.5% ABV).

Samuel Smiths Organic Cider:

Made with the juice of organic cider apples, a medium dry cider with a brilliant straw colour. Light of body with a clean apple flavour and a gentle apple blossom finish. (5% ABV)

Samuel Smiths Organic Perry:

Soil Association approved lands yield the finest organic fruit and our perry is made to an original recipe using only the juice of the finest organic pears. Full of pear flavour with a light character and medium finish, this is perry as it should be. (5% ABV)

Duché de Longueville Normandie Ciders:

Duché de Longueville creates naturally sparkling vintage ciders from Normandy made exclusively from pure pressed apple and pear juice (not concentrate). The juices comes from apples grown in the orchards of a 650 hectare estate near Dieppe in Normandy which are pollinated by bees coming from hives strategically placed around the orchard. The ciders have a fine mousse that comes from the natural fermentation.

Duché De Longueville Brut - Dry Cider:

Produced in the heart of Normandy, this dry cider is made exclusively with Norman cider apples. Serve chilled, this full-bodied, rich, dry cider is ideal with crepes, grilled poultry and fish. (5% ABV)

Duché De Longueville Poire - Pear Cider:

Made using the finest naturally fermented pears, Duche de Longueville pear cider has a unique and refreshing flavour. (2% ABV)

Muscadet de Dieppe:

This authentic Normandy cider is made with a minimum of 90% apples of the 'Muscadet de Dieppe' variety. This authentic cider from Normandy has a deep golden colour and a light flavour with hints of honey and Linden flowers. (2% ABV)

WATERS:

Kilbroney pure water is drawn from a natural source deep within the beautiful Glens of Antrim.
